#### POINTS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Competitors must have competed at a minimum of 3 of the 5 shows of the series to qualify for a placing in the relevant Points Championships.

The following points will be awarded in all classes <u>regardless of final placing in</u> <u>the class</u>:-

58%-59.9% - 1 point	60%-61.9% - 2 points
62%-63.9% - 3 points	64%-65.9% - 4 points
66%-67.9% - 5 points	68%-69.9% - 6 points
70%-71.9% - 7 points	72%-73.9% - 8 points
74%-75.9% - 9 points	Over 76% - 10 points

Points awarded in each section will accumulate over the 5 competition dates. Presentations of the Points Winner Challenge Trophies of each section will be made at the final show of the series. Championship Rosettes will be awarded to 10<sup>th</sup> place in each of the 5 sections.

The competitor (adult or junior) gaining the overall highest number of points on one horse/pony over the 5 shows will receive the **Sunshine Rhapsody Challenge Trophy** *kindly donated by Nicola Staples.* 

In the event of a tie, the competitor with the highest collective marks total scored in the relevant section over the series will be the winner.

## Just-So Winter Dressage Series Conditions of Entry

- 1. <u>Entries can only be made on line from the Just-So Equestrian events website</u> by the closing date. www.just-soequestrianevents.co.uk
- 2. <u>No refund of entry fees will be made unless a veterinary or medical certificate is produced</u>, in which case 50% of the entry fee will be returned
- 3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason.
- 4. British Dressage rules apply. <u>Bitless Bridle competitors are welcomed but will incur a 2</u> <u>mark penalty.</u> No horse or pony under the age of 4 years may compete.
- 5. Competitors must be correctly dressed for their class and <u>ALL RIDERS OF HORSES</u> <u>AND PONIES MUST WEAR A **HARD HAT COMPLIANT WITH THE 2022 BRITISH DRESSAGE RULES** WHEN MOUNTED ANYWHERE ON THE SHOWGROUND. THIS <u>RULE APPLIES TO EVERYONE WHEN MOUNTED AND WILL INVOLVE</u> <u>DISQUALIFICATION FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT COMPLY.</u></u>
- 6. Misuse of whips and spurs will entail immediate elimination.
- 7. The judge's decision is final.
- 8. Objections must be lodged with the Secretary, in writing, with a deposit of £25 within 15 minutes of the incident occurring. The deposit is only returnable if the objection is upheld.
- 9. Any person(s) riding in a manner likely to endanger the safety of themselves or others will be asked to dismount and leave the showground.
- 10. Any person or vehicle/horse/pony in their charge seen damaging the property of Arrow Riding Centre will be held responsible for the cost of reinstating the damage and charged accordingly.
- 11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any aspect of the Just-So Dressage Series at any time, due to circumstances beyond their control. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded minus a £2.00 administration fee.
- 12. Lunging is not allowed on any part of the showground
- 13. Competitors are asked not to muck out horse boxes/trailers on the showground and to take their litter home with them or use the bins provided
- 14. No dogs allowed other than within the confines of the owner's vehicle.
- 15. Health & Safety the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
